<p>To increase the number of students in years 1-6 achieving an A or B grade in English</p>	<p>2022: At Year 3 we met the NAPLAN target of more than 62% of students at or above SEA (67%) We exceeded the target of 23% of students in HB (36%) In PATR, 86% of Year 3 students achieved SEA. At Year 4, we did not meet the Year 4 PATR target of 66% at or above (62.1) At Year 5, we did exceeded the target of more than 58% of students at or above SEA (69%) In PATR, 67.7% of students achieved SEA. Our 30% HB target was not met (19%) At year 6 we did not meet the target of more than 85% of students at SEA or above (65.7%) In PATR, 74.2% of students achieved SEA.</p> <p>2023: 60 % of year 2 students (21 out of 35 students) to achieve B grade or better in English for their end of year report in 2023 (based on 51% of students achieving B grade or higher end of term 4 achievement report) 44% of year 4 students (23 out of 52 students) to achieve B grade or better in English for their end of year report in 2023 (based on 33% of students achieving B grade or higher end of term 4 achievement report) 48% of year 6 students (15 out of 31 students) to achieve B grade or better in English for their end of year report in 2023 (based on 39% of students achieving B grade or higher end of term 4 achievement report)</p>	<p>If we strengthen how we explicitly teach the strands of English with an intentional focus on the big six, explicit teaching of synthetic phonics, and daily writing activities to build vocabulary and cohesion, then we will see an increase in the number of students achieving an A or B grade in English</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Through 5 weekly data analysis we will see R-2 students progressively improve their ability to decode, blend, segment and substitute. • Through student work samples, students will demonstrate an increased understanding of spelling patterns, rules and generalisations in the four linguistic knowledges of spelling in Years 3-6. • Students will be able to articulate during classroom observations and walkthroughs an understanding of the lesson intentions aligned to the Big 6 and be able to articulate they are being stretched in their thinking.

To increase the number of students achieving SEA in Mathematics	<p>2022:</p> <p>At Year 3 we exceeded our target of 66% or more at SEA in Naplan (68%) We did not meet HB target of 18.7% (8%) In PATM, 95% of Year 3 students achieved SEA.</p> <p>At Year 4, we exceeded the target of 54% of students at SEA in PATM (72.4%) We did not meet high achievement target of 19% (0 students in top 2 stanines)</p> <p>At Year 5, we did not meet the target of 65% or more students at SEA in NAPLAN (61.7%) We did not meet the target of 30% of students in HB (5%). In PATM, 69.7% of Year 5 students met SEA.</p> <p>At Year 6, we did not meet the target of more than 67% of students at SEA in PATM (45%)</p>	<p>If we build teacher knowledge and capacity to teach number sense sequentially using the big ideas in number conceptual framework, and develop positive dispositions with students towards mathematical mastery then we will increase the number of students achieving in Maths</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Through regular class walkthroughs we will see and hear students articulating a positive mindset and using mathematical vocabulary and reasoning like a mathematician. • Through book checks, work samples and dialogic talk, we will see students demonstrating an understanding of what numbers mean, understanding their relationship to one another, performing mental mathematics, understanding symbolic representations and using numbers in real life situations.
